## CAMP ADMISSION

Boys at the current age of 8-17 are eligible to enroll (NCAA rules exclude current high school graduates.) Complete the application form and return it with a check or money order in the amount of \$50. This will be your camp deposit and the balance of your tuition will be due on the registration date. All cancellations must be received at least 14 days prior to the start of camp in order to receive a refund.

## CAMP FACILITIES

All camp activities will take place on the beautiful campus of Saginaw Valley State University in University Center, Michigan. The Ryder Center, which houses five regulation basketball floors all with glass backboards, will be our basketball headquarters. Other recreational facilities (such as our Olympic size swimming pool) will also be available for use during free time. All camp activities will be constantly supervised by the camp staff.

## CAMP MEALS / HOUSING

“All you can eat” meals will be professionally catered and served in the modern Doan Center which is the SVSU campus dining facility. All overnight campers will be housed in campus residence halls. Dorm and cafeteria supervision are provided by camp staff.
