ABOUT THE CAMP DIRECTOR

Andy Bethune became the head men's golf coach at Saginaw Valley State University on June 1, 2002. Bethune competed on the SVSU golf team and earned four varsity letters (1983-87). He became a member of the PGA of America in 1991.

Since taking over, the Cardinal golf team has steadily improved. The team stroke average has improved each season and SVSU has finished in the top five in each of the GLIAC Championships Bethune has coached. The team narrowly missed qualifying for the NCAA Championship in 2004, finishing second in the NCAA Super Regional in Kentucky.

Coach Bethune has 17 years experience coaching and training golfers of all skill levels. His approach includes extensive use of video and training aids. Many of his students have enjoyed success at the collegiate level and beyond.

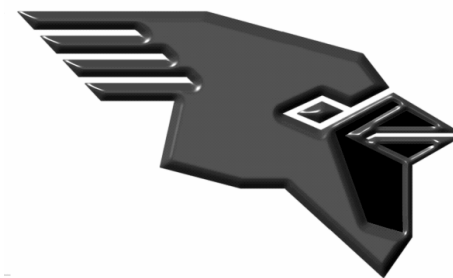
