

Clearpass Registration

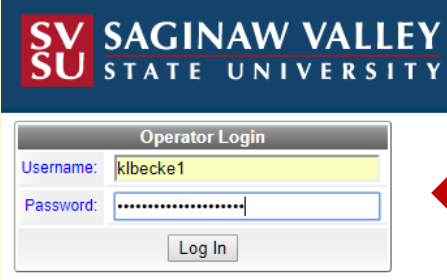

1. Visit the clearpass login page.
2. Type your SVSU username and password, and click **Login**.
3. Click **Create Device** (located on the left side pane).
4. Type the information requested in the fields provided.
5. **Device Name**: Give the device a name, e.g., John Doe's Laptop.
6. **MACAddress**: The device's unique MAC address.
7. **AirGroup**: Checked by default, AirGroup allows your device to be made available to others. This must be checked for wireless printing.
8. Click **Create Device**.

NOTE: There is a max of ten devices per user.

- **SVSUSecure** requires your username and password. Clearpass is not needed.
- **SVSU-Media-Gaming In Housing Wired devices** (all) require registration to fully function on our network except for gaming devices.
