Saginaw Valley State University Student Withdraw Checklist

Note: Each office listed below should be consulted with prior to withdrawing from the university.

Contact an SVSU Academic Advisor or the Office of Multicultural Services (W260) to discuss your intentions to withdrawal. Academic Advisors will assist you in discussing your academic options, academic standing, and plans for pursuing academic goals at Saginaw Valley or another institution.

Any student that is employed on campus through Regular Student Employment, Michigan Work-Study Funds, and/or Federal Work-Study Funds must contact Career Services and notify them of their withdrawal, as employment will be affected immediately.

Any student interested in completely withdrawing, that has any type of financial aid (loans, work-study, grants, and scholarships) or needs to resolve any unpaid charges and/or outstanding balance(s) on your university account must contact the Campus Financial Services Center.

If you live on-campus, contact the Housing Operations office to cancel your housing contract. Cancellation fees and pro-rated daily charges may apply. Additionally, if you have a meal plan and/or declining balance, make sure those are also cancelled on your student account.
