The DISTINCTIVE PROGRAM IN MUSIC CHOLARSHIPS are awarded to students who, due to their exceptional music performing ability and outstanding course work in music or music education, will bring distinction to the department. Students selected to receive this award will also become part of the music ambassadors to the schools program. The scholarship is awarded for one academic year, and is renewed annually if all scholarship criteria are met. The RHEA MILLER **SCHOLARSHIPS** in music are awarded based on an audition, interview, and musicianship tests. The scholarship is initially awarded for one academic year, and is renewed annually if all scholarship criteria are met. The PATSY HILL SCHWARTZ SCHOLARSHIP is given to a student who has shown leadership in the department of music and has demonstrated high academic achievement in music. It is awarded for one academic year. MARCHING BAND AND PEP BAND SCHOLARSHIPS are available. The marching band scholarship has a value of approximately \$300 and the pep band scholarship is \$200. The BARBARA MITCHELL VOICE SCHOLARSHIP is open to music and music education students with a gpa of 2.5 or above. It is awarded for one academic year. The JAMES AND ROSEMARY HILL SCHOLARSHIP is open to music and music education students. The student must have an overall gpa of 2.75 With a 3.0 Gpa in music courses. This scholarship is based on financial need. It is awarded for one academic year. The TERRY AND JERRY DRAKE **SCHOLARSHIPS** are awarded to students living in bay, midland or saginaw counties, majoring in art or music with scholastic achievement and potential. Six scholarships are awarded




for one year each.
