What is Kratom?

Kratom is a herbal substance that can produce opioid and stimulant like effects. It can also boost energy, reduce cough, reduce depression, and alleviate pain.



What is Kratom used for?

People report using kratom to manage drug withdrawal symptoms and cravings (especially related to opioid use), pain, fatigue and mental health problems.

Drug interactions may influence the effects

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How does Kratom effect pregnancy?

When Kratom is used during pregnancy, the baby may be born with symptoms of withdrawal that require treatment.

How is Kratom used?

Mostly, it is used orally in the form of tablets, capsules, or extract. Kratom leaves may also be dried out and used in tea, or the Kratom leaf can be chewed.



Effects on the body

At low doses: it increases alertness, physical energy, and talkativeness.

At high doses: causes hallucinations, delusion, confusion, Nausea, itching, sweating, dry mouth, constipation, increased urination, and loss of appetite.
